The policies and procedures have been implemented so that there is a clear understanding of what is expected of both athletes and parents involved in our program. Our goal is to provide a productive and positive experience for the children, parents, and the coaching staff. We are looking forward to facilitating the growth of your child in the sport of diving.

MISSION STATEMENT

The mission of the Legacy Diving Program is to promote the sport of diving within a safe and positive environment. Our main objective is to teach the proper mechanics and techniques of diving, which is an essential foundation and progression to success in the sport of diving.

FACILITY

Eastern Michigan University Jones Natatorium

We are located in the Michael H. Jones Natatorium on the campus of Eastern Michigan University. We train in a beautiful 50m x 25 yd. pool. We have the following equipment for our diving program:

- Indoor diving facility
 - 17' pool depth
- Two- 1 meter (2013) Two- 3 meter (2014) springboards on concrete.
 - 1, 5, 7.5 & 10 meter platforms with rough-tex surfacing.
 - Bubbler system to accelerate learning
 - 1m springboard water spotting rig
 - 3m springboard water spotting rig
 - 5m platform water spotting rig (first one in the nation)
 - Four trampolines, two with spotting rigs
 - Three Dry Boards, one with spotting rig
 - Floor/platform spotting rig
 - 30X6' carpeted spring floor
 - 8 sets of stall bars
 - Two 30X6'carpeted foam floors
- Five 32 inch flat screens with TIVO systems on all dry-land and water stations
 - Surround sound system in dry gym
 - 120" Projector screen with 1080P HD Projector in dry-land

Legacy Diving Coaching Staff

Buck Smith

Program Director

Coach Buck Smith is entering his 17th year as the Head Men's and Women's Diving Coach of Eastern Michigan University, During his tenure at Eastern Michigan University, Smith has qualified 8 female divers and 3 male diver to the NCAA Championships, while producing three NCAA All American's. Smith's divers have placed in the top eight at the Mid-American Conference Championships 159 times, won 23 MAC Championship titles, hold two MAC Championship records, as well as claiming five school records. He has also been named MAC Diving Coach of the Year 16 times between the men's and women's diving teams. In the 17-year history of Legacy Diving, Smith has had 232 national qualifiers, 136 junior national finalists, 15 national champions, 10 silver medalists and 11 bronze medalists. He has also had a Junior World Finalist and coached his team to seven Junior Olympic Regional titles, as well as three Junior Zone Championship titles. Smith has also coached six Canadian Junior Olympic National finalists. At the senior national level, Smith has had 49 Senior National qualifiers, 28 finalists, 3 silver medalists, and 2 national champions. In 2012, four former and current Legacy divers qualified for Olympic Trials. Buck was also the head coach and team leader for the USA Diving National team who competed at the Grand Prix in Rostock, Germany in 2012. Buck is married to wife Kara Smith and they have two girls ages 10 and 8, Allie and Karlie.

Michigan & National Team Head Coach Coach Ed Goodman has been coaching with Legacy Diving for the past year and was Head Diving Coach at Moss Farms Diving in Moultrie, Georgia from 2005-2014. During his tenure, he coached a variety of talented young athletes, including Ryan Helms, a Senior National Champion and bronze medalist at the Junior Pan Am Games. Coach Goodman's past divers hold multiple Georgia high school state records and have made impressive competitive appearances at Junior Olympic National Championships. Coach Goodman has an extensive background in competitive diving, gymnastics, tumbling, trampoline, plus years of experience coaching his own teams. Ed hails from the Florida Keys, where he was responsible for developing the Islamorada Diving Club. He's also enjoyed coaching positions with the Ft. Lauderdale Diving Team, as well as the University of Toledo, Ohio, and the Sylvania Diving Club. Prior to embarking on his coaching career, Ed was an NCAA national qualifier at the University of Cincinnati, a national Junior Olympic diving champion in 1977, and a two-time world age-group tumbling champion.

Intermediate Team Program Information

Intermediate Team Program Criteria

This team is designated for those divers who were successful in our Learn to Dive Team program and demonstrated/passed the basic skills on all stations in order to progress on to a more consistent and intensive program. These divers are encouraged to commit to practicing **2x/week minimum** and compete in at least two of the Michigan Diving Association meets, as well as the State meet. The Intermediate Team program will feed into our Michigan Team program. Divers will have instruction on the proper basics and mechanics on 1m & 3m springboard, as well as trampoline, dry-board, and belts.

Days & Times

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday: 5:00pm-7:00pm

Sunday: 1:15pm-3:15pm

<u>United States Diving Membership</u>: *All* Divers must join USD in order to dive in our program. The USD membership cost is \$20. Please visit <u>www.usadiving.org</u>, Click on Membership – Join Now – Competitive Blue Membership. Fill out all of the information including Association: Michigan, as well as

Team: Legacy Diving. You must print off the membership card and present a copy before your first practice.

REC/IM ID CARD— \$5.00 (one-time fee paid to the REC directly!)

SESSION FEE:

One practice per week \$300/12\$ week session + \$60 membership = \$360 Two practices per week \$525/12\$ week session + \$75 membership = \$600 Three practices per week \$600/12\$ week session + \$100 membership = \$700 Four practices per week \$675/12\$ week session + \$100 membership = \$775

*If you pay full amount up front by check, you will receive 10% off!
You will be billed the entire amount in the beginning of the session. However,
Legacy Diving permits our members to pay ½ up front, and the remaining balance
mid-way through the session.

NOTE: If you have 2 divers in the program you will receive 10% off of your second child's total cost. If you have 3 or more, you will receive 20% off of your 2nd and 3rd child's total cost.

LEGACY MEMBERSHIP FEE:

This fee is already included in your session fee. The fee covers pool rental, Michigan Diving Association fee, and Legacy Membership.

COMPETITION/COACHING FEE

\$15/event coaching fee for any MDA Future Champion events or \$25/event JO USD. *All registration fees for competitions will be paid by each individual diver to Legacy Diving. Legacy Diving will pay the meet director with one team check.

Legacy Diving Billing Policies

- 1. After we receive your registration form/liability form, we will add your Name and E-mail to our billing website. Once added, you will have a Legacy Diving Account and will receive a username and password via e-mail. Be SURE to submit the Parents Name and E-mail address on the registration form that you would prefer to be listed as the Legacy Account Manager. You will then receive an e-mail requesting payment. We prefer that you pay on-line via pay-pal when you receive this e-mail. However, we do have a drop-box located in our dry-land area if you prefer to submit a check.
- 2. Training fees will **only** be pro-rated when practice is not being offered due to a cancellation or if a new diver starts after a session has already begun. If you miss a scheduled practice due to vacation or illness, you can try to make it up on another day that practice is offered.
 - a. Exception: major illness or injury
- 3. Please designate the number days you will be practicing when registering.
- 4. Families with more than one diver in the program will receive 10% off of their second child's total cost. A family with more than two divers in the program will receive 20% off their second and third child's total cost.
- 5. Competitive divers are responsible for paying all meet entrance fees in advance. In most cases, meet fees are non-refundable. Divers are responsible for their own travel costs for each meet.
- 6. Competitive divers are responsible for paying all meet registration fees in advance. For a MDA meet, you will be able to submit one check to Legacy Diving including the Legacy Coaching fee and Meet registration fee. In most cases, meet fees are non-refundable. Divers are responsible for their own travel costs for each meet.
- 7. Legacy Meet Coaching Fee: The following fee will be collected by the Legacy Parents Committee prior to leaving for the competition:
 - a. \$15/event for Michigan Diving Association Future Champions events.
 - b. \$25/event for JO USD events.
- 8. *Please note: If the total cost of the coaches time and travel expenses is greater than the coaching fees that are listed above, than the total cost will be divided amongst the divers competing in that meet.

Behavior Policies

Divers Role

All divers are required to follow all of the rules of EMU and the Rec. building, as well as Legacy Diving rules. It is expected that all divers respect ALL coaches on the coaching staff, as well as fellow divers. Divers exhibiting poor behavior or bad attitudes will be asked to leave practice. Repeated attitude or behavior problems will result in removal from the program.

Parental Role

Please refer to the Legacy Diving Parents Handbook for more details.

All parents who wish to stay and observe their child's training session <u>must</u> sit in the bleacher area upstairs. Parents may not observe from the pool deck. Our intention is not to alienate the parents, but rather to provide the safest training and learning environment possible. Our experience has shown that it is distracting to the divers, as well as the coaches when parents are on the pool deck. From a safety standpoint, quite often the divers are watching their parents and not the coaches. We need to have the full attention of the divers while they are in our care. We respectfully ask all parents to refrain from talking to the coaches during training time so that we may concentrate on the divers progression, as well as their safety. At <u>no</u> time should you coach your son/daughter before, during, or after practice. Skill Level

The coaching staff will determine when a diver has learned the skills necessary to move up to the next level. When specific skills are performed well enough, and the diver exhibits a strong work ethic, are able to make corrections quickly, and are emotionally ready, they will be asked to move up to the next level. It is important that the skills in each level are mastered before moving on, not only for a solid fundamental base with proper mechanics, but also for safety purposes.

Attendance and Tardiness

Tardiness is not acceptable. All divers are expected to arrive before their class is scheduled to begin. Team members are expected to be on time and to attend all team meetings.

Make-up Policy

Due to the class structure, make-up classes will only be permitted according to available space. You must request the make-up in advance and receive permission to come to the requested practice. Make-up classes will not be scheduled for classes that happen to fall on holidays.
