Welcome to the Legacy Diving Michigan Team and National Team. You have been selected by our coaching staff to be a member on our Travel Team. This selection was based upon your ability level and potential, as well as your desire to compete in Junior Olympic 1m, 3m, Platform (N.T.) USD and MDA competitions. As a part of the Michigan Team you are required to practice a minimum of 3x-4x/week. The National Team is required to practice a minimum of 4x-5x/week. The coaching staff is looking forward to working with athletes who have a great work ethic, enthusiasm to learn and make corrections, and excel in the sport of diving. This is a full year commitment both physically and mentally for the diver, as well as a financial commitment for the parents. In addition, we will need all of the parents and divers to volunteer with the running of any home meets or events that we host through Legacy.

FACILITY

Eastern Michigan University Jones Natatorium

We are located in the Michael H. Jones Natatorium on the campus of Eastern Michigan University. We train in a beautiful 50m x 25 yd. pool. We have the following equipment for our diving program:

 - > 17' pool depth
- ➤ Two-1 meter (2013) Two-3 meter (2014) springboards on concrete.
 - > 1, 5, 7.5 & 10 meter platforms with rough-tex surfacing.
 - > Bubbler system to accelerate learning
 - > 1m springboard water spotting rig
 - > 3m springboard water spotting rig
 - > 5m platform water spotting rig (first one in the nation)
 - Four trampolines, two with spotting rigs
 - ➤ Three Dry Boards, one with spotting rig
 - > Floor/platform spotting rig
 - ➤ 30X6' carpeted spring floor
 - ➤ 8 sets of stall bars
 - ➤ Two 30X6'carpeted foam floors
- Five 32 inch flat screens with TIVO systems on all dry-land and water stations
 - Surround sound system in dry gym
 - ➤ 120" Projector screen with 1080P HD Projector in dry-land

Legacy Diving Coaching Staff

Buck Smith

Program Director

Coach Buck Smith is entering his 17th year as the Head Men's and Women's Diving Coach of Eastern Michigan University. During his tenure at Eastern Michigan University, Smith has qualified 8 female divers and 3 male diver to the NCAA Championships, while producing three NCAA All American's. Smith's divers have placed in the top eight at the Mid-American Conference Championships 159 times, won 23 MAC Championship titles, hold two MAC Championship records, as well as claiming five school records. He has also been named MAC Diving Coach of the Year 16 times between the men's and women's diving teams. In the 17-year history of Legacy Diving, Smith has had 232 national qualifiers, 136 junior national finalists, 15 national champions, 10 silver medalists and 11 bronze medalists. He has also had a Junior World Finalist and coached his team to seven Junior Olympic Regional titles, as well as three Junior Zone Championship titles. Smith has also coached six Canadian Junior Olympic National finalists. At the senior national level, Smith has had 49 Senior National qualifiers, 28 finalists, 3 silver medalists, and 2 national champions. In 2012, four former and current Legacy divers qualified for Olympic Trials. Buck was also the head coach and team leader for the USA Diving National team who competed at the Grand Prix in Rostock, Germany in 2012. Buck is married to wife Kara Smith and they have two girls ages 10 and 8, Allie and Karlie.

Ed Goodman

Michigan & National Team Head Coach Coach Ed Goodman has been coaching with Legacy Diving for the past year and was Head Diving Coach at Moss Farms Diving in Moultrie, Georgia from 2005-2014. During his tenure, he coached a variety of talented young athletes, including Ryan Helms, a Senior National Champion and bronze medalist at the Junior Pan Am Games. Coach Goodman's past divers hold multiple Georgia high school state records and have made impressive competitive appearances at Junior Olympic National Championships. Coach Goodman has an extensive background in competitive diving, gymnastics, tumbling, trampoline, plus years of experience coaching his own teams. Ed hails from the Florida Keys, where he was responsible for developing the Islamorada Diving Club. He's also enjoyed coaching positions with the Ft. Lauderdale Diving Team, as well as the University of Toledo, Ohio, and the Sylvania Diving Club. Prior to embarking on his coaching career, Ed was an NCAA national qualifier at the University of Cincinnati, a national Junior Olympic diving champion in 1977, and a two-time world age-group tumbling champion.

Legacy Diving Contract

Billing

- 1. After we receive your registration form/liability form, we will add your Name and E-mail to our billing website. Once added, you will have a Legacy Diving Account and will receive a username and password via e-mail. Be SURE to submit the Parents Name and E-mail address on the registration form that you would prefer to be listed as the Legacy Account Manager. You will then receive an e-mail requesting payment. We prefer that you pay on-line via pay-pal when you receive this e-mail. However, we do have a drop-box located in our dry-land area if you prefer to submit a check.
- 2. You will also pay for the first of three payments of the pool rental & membership fee in September via check.
 - 1. M.T. =\$900: 4 payments of \$225 in September, December, March, and June.
 - 2. N.T. =\$1,100: 4 payments of \$275 in September, December, March, and June.

- 4. Michigan Team and National Team divers will be billed monthly, regardless of whether or not they attend practice regularly.
 - a. Vacation, breaks, etc...You will still be responsible for the full month of training fees.
 - b. Athlete injury or major illness will be handled on an individual basis with regards to billing.
 - c. If a diver competes on a H.S. team and is not able to come to all Legacy practices, you will be billed a pro-rated training fee for the H.S. season.
- 5. Training fees will only be pro-rated if a new diver starts after a session has already begun. Remember that you are reserving a spot on the team. The Michigan Team and National Team's are an all-year round commitment.
- 6. If you are thinking about taking a break, you must have prior approval from the Head Coach, Buck Smith. You may continue to pay for your spot and it will be held for you. However, if you do not discuss this with the head coach, you may not have a spot available to you, if you decide to return.
- 7. Families with more than one diver in the program will receive 10% off of their second child's total cost. A family with more than two divers in the program will receive 20% off their second and third child's total cost.
- 8. The purchase of a team suit, t-shirt, warm-up, and bag is mandatory for all Michigan Team and National Team Members.

Competition Billing

1. Competitive divers are responsible for paying all meet registration fees in advance. For a MDA meet, you will be able to submit one check to Legacy Diving which includes your Legacy Coaching fee, and your Meet registration fee. For a USD meet, you will need to go on-line to diversets.com to register by the

- deadline for the competition. In most cases, meet fees are non-refundable. Divers are responsible for their own travel costs for each meet.
- 2. Legacy Meet Coaching Fee: The following fee will be collected by the Legacy Parents Committee prior to leaving for the competition:
 - a. \$30/meet for Michigan Diving Association JO events.
 - b. \$25/event for USD Junior Regional competitions
 - c. \$50/event for Junior Zone and Senior Zone competition.
 - d. \$75/event for any Junior or Senior National competition.
- 3. *Please note: If the total cost of the coaches time and travel expenses is greater than the coaching fees that are listed above, than the total cost will be divided amongst the divers competing in that meet.

Behavior

Divers Role

- 1. All divers are required to follow all of the rules of EMU and the Rec. building, as well as Legacy Diving rules.
- 2. It is expected that all divers respect *ALL* coaches on the coaching staff, as well as fellow divers.
- 3. Divers exhibiting poor behavior or bad attitudes will be asked to leave practice.
- 4. Repeated attitude or behavior problems will result in removal from the program.
- 5. Divers are expected to attend all scheduled practices.
- 6. Please let the head coach know if you will be missing a practice and the reason for your absence.
- 7. Tardiness is not acceptable. If you are late to practice, you must let the coaches know why you were late.
- 8. The diver is responsible for all communication with the head coach or coaching staff. Any questions, conflicts, injuries, should be discussed between the coach and the diver.
- 9. The diver is not to learn any new dives on their own or with any other diving program.
- 10. The diver must receive permission to dive with any other coach or program.
- 11. A diver may not decide what dives they will be competing at a competition. The coach will make those decisions.

Parental Role

- 1. All parents who wish to stay and observe their son/daughter's training session *must* sit in the bleacher area upstairs. Parents may not observe on the pool deck.
- 2. At no time should you coach your son/daughter before, during, or after practice.
